- ◆ Please fill out the appropriate form carefully, with clear detail, and attach securely to the entry and sample. This is very important so that the judges can have as much detail as possible about your hand dyed entry.

*\* If you are submitting multiple entries, we strongly recommend that you put each entry, along with its paperwork, in a separate clear bag. This will avoid possible mix-ups when the volunteers unpack them for display.*
